**Subject: - Provisional Security Clearance for Worldmark-I, Asset No. 11, Aerocity, New Delhi.**

Sir,

I am directed by the competent authority to convey **Provisional Security Clearance** for Worldmark-I, Asset No. 11, Aerocity, New Delhi on the basis of the inspection conducted by the Inspection Committee, subject to the approval of security programme by the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security, with the following conditions;

- i. ARC hanger is clearly visible from the glasses of North & Northwestern part of Tower-A&B from 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Floor. It must have toughened glass with B.R. films as tested and approved by DRDO and Technical Specification Committee of Ministry of Civil Aviation or closed with bricks wall as done by hotels.

In this regard, Shri Pankaj Rathi, Director Aspen Buildtech Limited has given an affidavit that by the time the approval for installation of toughened glass with BR film as tested by DRDO and approved by the Technical Specification Committee of Ministry of Civil Aviation obtained, they shall put a view cutter of 12mm cement fiber board layered with 1.5mm GI sheet certified by Dr. Santosh Kumar Singh, Director, Structures Engineering Design and Research Pvt. Ltd. that the identified cement fiber board, which has ruptured strength having three times higher than the brick work and recommend use of 12mm thick cement fiber board with 1.5mm thick GI sheet backing to serve as an armor. This arrangement shall have equivalent strength as half brick thick wall and may be used as an alternate provision.

- ii. No changes will be made in the security measures inspected and approved by the Inspection Committee without permission from the local police on the basis of security assessment by the Inspection Committee.

- iii. Tenants/officials/vendor's vehicles must have RFID tags on wind screen.

Further you should apply for permission for other activities to concerned Civil agencies.
